WINEMAKING

All the grapes are carefully selected and harvested in the Anjou region from vineyards planted on schisteous and shale soils. The combination of the exceptional terroir and temperate climate from the Loire produce diverse types of Rosé: dry Rosé de Loire, medium-dry Rosé d'Anjou, sweet Cabernet d'Anjou. Just like the climate of the region, this Rosé d'Anjou is tender and slightly sweet.

PACKAGING

Ackerman Rosé d'Anjou comes in an elegant and traditional bottle.

TASTING NOTES

Colour : bright pink with purple glints.

Nose : on red fruits and citrus.

Palate : very fruity, very balanced between residual sugars and moderate acidity of 2015 vintage. Red currant and raspberry are dominating.

FOOD PAIRING

This food-friendly wine matches Asian and Indian cuisine, grilled fishes, cold meat, fruit salads.
