SINGLE VINEYARD STEVENS SEMILLON 2011

VINEYARD – The Stevens Semillon was harvested from the Glenoak Vineyard owned by Neil Stevens.

SOIL – This undulating vineyard is situated on a combination of light sand and red clay soils.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS – A late spring which led into cooler conditions throughout November and early December with some rain. This led up left us with above average crop levels which ripened well with the warmer weather in January. Picking began one later than 2010.

DATE PICKED – 27 - 28 January 2011

WINEMAKER'S NOTES – After a relatively cool fermentation, the wine spent a minimal time on yeast lees before being bottled early to maintain its freshness. No oak fermentation or maturation.

WINE ANALYSIS – Alc 11.0% pH 2.96 TA 7.06g/L

DATE BOTTLED – 8 - 9 June 2011

TASTING NOTES – The nose shows fresh citrus and floral characters associated with this vineyard. The palate is dominated by lime characters with a mineral edge showing good length with a soft, approachable acid structure.

AWARDS – The 2011 vintage has won 7 gold, 3 silver and 14 bronze medals.
