



K1 by *Geoff Hardy*

2016 Pinot Noir *Adelaide Hills*

Story: The K1 vines are of low yield and are pruned to arched canes for extra light interception on the fruit and optimum balance. Hand harvesting the fruit ensures that the grapes are in top condition for the traditional vinification.

Vintage: The 2016 vintage was in general very mild with low rainfall. The lack of rain looked like it would result in a quick harvest, but a big downpour in early February made sure the vintage was more evenly spread out. The yields were up on the couple of previous years and the quality is looking great.

Nose: The K1 Pinot Noir exhibits aromas of black cherries, fresh green field strawberries and sweet raspberries.

Palate: The palate is light and fun with the aromas on the nose following through, complemented by good tannins including some stalky tannin flavours from whole bunch fermentation.

Pairing: Try this wine with a wild duck dish or enjoy a glass or two with family and friends.

Cellaring: Drink now or to 2024
