### TASTING NOTES:

Marsanne, one of the world's rarest grape varieties, was first planted at Tahbilk during the late 1860s and although none of these vines have survived, the Estate produces Marsanne from plantings established in 1927, arguably the oldest in the world.

The bouquet and palate of this unique, unwooded style, exhibit intense aromas of honeysuckle and toast with a tight mineral edge whilst the finish is long and flavoursome balanced with crisp acidity.

These complex flavours will develop further with more bottle age and the wine will be drinking at its best in 2020.
