### Winemakers Notes

Vineyard	A single vineyard wine on predominantly weathered gravels threaded with clay.
Vintage Conditions	A hot Summer provided the base for an early vintage. Rain just prior slowed ripening down somewhat but good fruit flavours developed in the picked fruit.
Harvest Date	4th - 7th April 2016
Fermentation/maturation	100% Stainless Steel
Alcohol	13.5 %
Residual Sugar	6 g/L
Acid	7.5g/L

General Comments	An elegant floral bouquet teamed with dried pears leading to a rich, fleshy palate of ginger and spice.
Hue	Clear, straw yellow.
Nose	Rose petals and dried pears
Palate	Elegant, rich and fleshy with ginger and spice.
Length	Silky, fruit driven depth.
Cellar	3 years
