### Winemaker's Notes

**Vineyard** - Single vineyard in the Nelson region.

**Soil** - A mix of Moutere clay and stony alluvial.

**Vintage Conditions** - An outstanding vintage with perfect conditions. Phenolic ripeness was reached earlier than usual, resulting in one of the earliest harvests in the Nelson region. Resulting fruit was ripe, clean and in excellent condition, producing wines which express vibrancy, fruit concentration and complexity.

**Fermentation/maturation** - 100% Stainless steel

**Alcohol** - 12.5%

**Residual Sugar** - 5 g/L

**Total Acidity** - 8.9 g/L

**Tasting Notes / General Comments** - A fresh, herbaceous Sauvignon Blanc displaying classic cool-climate tropical flavours of citrus & passionfruit with a lively crisp finish.

**Hue** - Clear Green Tinged

**Nose** - Herbaceous and fresh

**Palate** - Lively citrus and passionfruit.

**Length** - Fresh & crisp with lively minerality.

**Cellar** - Drink young and fresh or cellar up to 2 years

**Serving Suggestions** - Serve chilled with fresh oysters, new season's asparagus and salads.
