



TUCK'S RIDGE  
BUCKLE CHARDONNAY 2012



**Tasting note**

Light straw green with luscious apple, white peach and fig aromas backed up with an intense and detailed pallet. Yielded at a very low 1.2 tonnes per acre and spending a relatively short time in oak gives this wine the complexity it requires, but in a subtle non offensive manner. The 2012 vintage will age slowly but steadily, if you are patient you will reap the rewards.

*'Light straw-green; the fragrant bouquet is promptly backed up by the intense and detailed palate; Penfolds P58 clone shines wherever it is grown, the low yield (here .1.2 tonnes per acre) the only downside. What is truly remarkable is the low baume (11.5°) and corresponding low alcohol, neither diminishing the varietal expression courtesy of grapefruit, white peach and green apple.*
