Tasting note

An amazing cherry laden lifted nose, augmented by forest fruit and a little vanilla. The palate has wonderful attack with fine, layered, spreading tannins and a little savoury undergrowth on the finish. This wine will live for 20 or more years and the longer you can wait, the happier you will be.

'Hand-picked, crushed/pressed, matured in French oak about the sheer class of the bouquet and palate; cherry and plum are interleaved with delicate nuances of savoury, but superfine, tannins running through to an incredibly long, lingering finish. Grand Cru? You betcha.'
