PINOT NOIR 2014

This low yielding vintage has paid off! Concentrated cherry, plum and blackberry aromas to start. Hints of rhubarb and smoky notes. How's the complexity? Gentle tannin and acid providing a perfect balance to the well- defined and vibrant fruit. The generosity of fruit flavour continues on the palate with the addition of spice and clove. A great vintage of a fantastic wine to be enjoyed in the years to come.
