

2015 White Label Sauvignon Blanc

The Alkoomi vineyards and winery are located in the Frankland River district of Western Australia's Great Southern wine region. The name is taken from local aboriginal dialect and means 'a place we chose' and the logo represents the unique and distinctively Australian Grass tree, *Xanthorrhoea preissii*. The first plantings were in 1971 and the region's long, cool ripening conditions are perfect for growing fruit of intense varietal character.



Winemaking

The fruit was harvested at optimal ripeness in the early hours of the morning and pressed to tank. After cold settling the juice was fermented in tank and kept on lees post fermentation to improve mouthfeel and complexity, before an early bottling to retain freshness.

Vintage

A cool wet winter and early spring was followed by a warm even summer with well-timed rainfall and a typically cool autumn. This resulted in perfect ripening conditions and provided an intense flavour profile with optimal natural acidity.

Colour

Brilliant very pale straw with emerald hues.

Nose

Lifted aromas of gooseberry and cut grass are complemented by tropical notes of passionfruit and guava.

Palate

The delicate palate has an abundance of tropical fruits with underlying citrus and herbaceous notes; all supported by a backbone of mouth-watering acidity and culminating in a crisp juicy finish.

Cellaring

Ready to enjoy now.
