



2015 Lagrein Limestone Coast / Adelaide Hills

Story: Lagrein is a relatively curious north east Italian grape variety well suited to Australian viticultural sites. While it's early days for this variety in the Wirrega Vineyard, if this wine is anything to go by we certainly have something to look forward to.

Vintage: Early winter in 2014 was wetter than usual and the period from August to early January was very dry with above average temperatures. Following some rain and milder temperatures in January, the 2015 harvest started later that month and was quite condensed, resulting in some fabulous white and red wines.

Nose: The nose offers dense aromas of blackberries, cocoa and rose geranium with notes of cloves and freshly turned earth.

Palate: The palate is rich and velvety with notes of boysenberries, plums and white summer truffles, finished off with chalky tannins.

Pairing: Try with kangaroo fillet medallions served with a green olive, parsley and pine nut pesto.

Cellaring: Drink now or to 2025
