WINEMAKERS COMMENTS:

Redman Shiraz is made from grapes grown on vines that are over forty years old, and carefully hand pruned, on the Redman family vineyards in the heart of Coonawarra. The Winter and Spring rainfall leading into the 2018 season was excellent at 20% above long-term averages. A warm Spring along with a warm and dry Summer meant a really great growing season accumulating to a wonderful vintage.

The grapes were mechanically harvested and crushed in the field, fermentation started immediately using specially selected yeast and was carefully monitored in open concrete and stainless-steel fermenters. The wine was matured in American and French oak hogsheads for fourteen months prior to bottling in February 2020.

TASTING NOTES:

Colour: Medium red with purple tinges.

Bouquet: The nose shows pepper and spice, bright red fruits and cedar oak overtones

Palate: Medium bodied with soft round tannins complimented with sweet fruit. This full flavoured fruit driven wine has a long dry finish.
