### Tasting Note

This maybe a non-vintage but it's no alcopop. It has quite a bold, salmon pink colour with fine and persistent bubbles. Aromas of Jonagold apples, tart cherries, strawberries (of course) and perhaps a little cumin seed precede a palate which is at once richly fruity *and* dry *and* a little spicy. Fun and serious all at the same time.

### Winemaking

100% pinot noir – traditional method with 16 months on lees.

### Food

Prawns with a lightly-spiced mayo, salmon blinis, baby Thai fish cakes...in short anything fresh and delicious that you can eat with your fingers.
