## Soil & Varieties

45% Grenache, 45% Cinsault, 10% Syrah

Parcel selections on limestone-clay soils and rolled pebbles.  
Yield 50 hl/ha



## Vinification

Grenache: 4 hours skin maceration

Cinsault and Syrah: direct pressing

Settling juices at low temperature

Clarification and alcoholic fermentation at 16 ° C (with selected yeasts).

Aging on fine lees for 2 months for Syrah

Clearing and filtering with bottling.



## Tasting

Light color with light purple hues.

On the nose, seductive aromas of red fruits, strawberry and raspberry. On the palate, they are complemented by floral notes. Generous, pleasant, it is a juicy rosé to enjoy any time, and delightful with meals.
